NOTE:

The Commercial Diving Association (Singapore) mandates that all members and relevant industry stakeholders shall ensure that any and all personnel engaged in commercial diving activities are, at all material times, provided with adequate instructions, relevant information, appropriate training, valid diving medical assessments, and effective supervision. Such provisions shall be sufficient to ensure that said personnel are competent to perform their duties safely and properly and in compliance with applicable standards and regulations.

Without prejudice to the foregoing, members and industry stakeholders shall further ensure that no individual shall be permitted to participate in any commercial diving activity unless such individual has been duly medically examined and certified as physically fit in accordance with recognised diving medical standards before the commencement of operations.

All medical certifications and assessments shall:

- (a) be conducted by suitably qualified and authorised medical practitioners;
- (b) comply with recognised industry and/or statutory diving medical standards; and
- (c) be carried out at such intervals as may be prescribed by applicable regulations or, in the absence thereof, at intervals sufficient to ensure continued fitness for diving.

Records of all such medical assessments and certifications shall be properly maintained, kept up to date, and made available for inspection by relevant authorities upon request, forming an integral part of the organisation's safety management and operational compliance framework.

Failure to comply with the above requirements may constitute a breach of applicable industry standards and regulatory obligations.
