

### **>A Note on Divers' Log Books**

Many countries require professional and commercial divers to maintain an accurate, up-to-date Diver's Log Book as part of occupational safety regulations.

The log book serves as a legal document that may be inspected by regulatory authorities, such as maritime safety agencies, enforcement / legal departments, or occupational health and safety inspectors.

Failing to maintain a log book can lead to fines, suspension of diving certification, or legal liability in case of an accident or fatality.
