

>A Note on Expired & Fraudulent Certificates

Many certificates in this industry come with expiry dates, and will become invalid once expired. It is important to monitor these dates closely and arrange for renewal or recertification in advance to avoid any lapses in compliance.

Do not alter, edit, falsify, or fabricate any certificate, medical certs or records. Falsified or fraudulent certificates are illegal under the Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Act, and those responsible may face fines and/or imprisonment.

It is increasingly common for companies and clients to verify certificates and even Log Books. The likelihood of detection is high, so maintaining authenticity is critical. By keeping all records legitimate, you can build a long-standing career with a solid professional reputation in the industry.
