

>Application of CDA(S) Competency Card

The CDA(S) Competency Card serves as an additional identification for commercial divers engaged in operations within inland and inshore waters of Singapore. An application for the CDA(S) Competency Card shall be submitted in accordance with the eligibility criteria prescribed under the Ministry of Manpower's (MOM) recognised standards. Applicants are required to demonstrate compliance by producing either a valid training qualification issued by a CDA(S) and MOM-recognised training provider, successful completion of an assessment-only pathway, or equivalent foreign qualifications recognised by the Ministry.

Applications must be accompanied by all requisite supporting documentation, including but not limited to proof of training qualification and a recent photograph, and shall be subject to the payment of the prescribed application fee. The Competency Card, upon issuance, shall remain valid for a specified period, after which renewal may be affected upon demonstration of continued compliance with the competency standards and regulatory requirements established by MOM.

General Provisions

CDA(S) reserves the right to amend, suspend, or revoke the Card in accordance with applicable regulations and standards, including where the holder fails to maintain the requisite competency or breaches any provisions of these Regulations.
