

## >If you want to be Commercial Diving Supervisor

### 1. Mandatory Training for Commercial Diving Supervisors

A Commercial Diving Supervisor must complete an accredited course at a Learning Service Provider (LSP) to obtain an Inland/Inshore Diving Supervisor certificate recognized by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM), Singapore.

The relevant courses are:

Level	Course Name	Scope
Level 3	Inland/Inshore Commercial Self-Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus (CSCUBA) Dive Supervisor	No decompression dives, up to 30 m
Level 4	Inland/Inshore Surface-Supplied Diving Equipment (SSDE) Dive Supervisor	Dives up to 30 m

- These courses are aligned with the Commercial Diving Competency Standards set by the Workplace Safety & Health Council and MOM.
- Courses are available at accredited LSPs.
- Funding options exist for **Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents**.

### 2. Recognition of Foreign Qualifications

- Some foreign dive supervisor certifications are recognized by CDAS & MOM.
- Example: IMCA Air Dive Supervisor qualification.
- A full list of accepted foreign qualifications is in the MOM Technical Notification (TN).

### 3. Assessment Only Pathway (AOP)

- Currently, there is no Assessment Only Pathway for experienced Dive Supervisors in Singapore.
- All candidates must complete the formal course at an LSP.
