Any individual seeking employment as a commercial diver in Singapore is invited to submit their curriculum vitae (“CV”) to the Commercial Divers Association (Singapore) (“CDA(S)”). Upon receipt, CDA(S) may forward such CVs to its member companies for their consideration. Notwithstanding the foregoing, applicants who have a specific company in mind retain the right to contact such company directly using the contact information provided on the “Contact Us” page of the relevant entity.

Divers, or any persons engaged in the commercial diving industry, who have concerns relating to safety may contact CDA(S) for guidance and advice. In circumstances of immediate or urgent safety concerns, it is recommended that such individuals contact the Ministry of Manpower (“MOM”) directly through the MOM Safety Hotline at 6317 1111.

In the jurisdiction of Singapore, commercial divers are classified within the sector of Shipbuilding and Marine Engineering. Accordingly, commercial divers seeking representation or support in matters relating to salary, employment conditions, or other industrial relations issues may consult with the Shipbuilding and Marine Engineering Employees’ Union (“SMEEU”). Membership in SMEEU is offered at a reasonable fee and provides, in addition to representation in employment matters, eligibility for training grants and access to certain benefits provided through NTUC-affiliated retail outlets.
